
What we do ...

Introduction

Edible Rotherhithe are a community based charity working to improve the understanding of growing and cooking techniques in Southwark. The summer school aims to introduce young people to careers in the built environment whilst creating designs for the varied workshops that they hold aiming to push intergenerational learning and community spirit.

This year we worked within Rotherhithe Primary School completing a trio of mobile structures for their edible gardening workshops (which have already seen an increase in interest). The students designed and built three movable objects and two new planters from recycled timber donated by Martinspeed.

The students visited a number of different industries; completed a workshop in an architecture office, a lecture in an engineering office, and a tour on one of London's largest construction sites.


